

SNOW REMOVAL TIPS FOR THE HOMEOWNER

**SHOVEL SNOW FROM YOUR DRIVEWAY AND SIDEWALK INTO YOUR YARD NOT THE STREET
IF YOU PUT IT IN THE STREET THE PLOW WILL PUSH IT BACK ONTO YOUR DRIVEWAY OR
SIDEWALK**

**REMOVING SNOW FROM YOUR PROPERTY (DRIVEWAY I SIDEWALK) AND PLACING IT IN THE
STREET IS PROHIBITED BY LAW**

**SHOVEL ALL SNOW TO THE RIGHT SIDE OF YOUR DRIVEWAY BECAUSE IF YOU LEAVE IT ON THE
LEFT SIDE THE PLOW WILL HIT THE PILE AND SPREAD IT IN BACK INTO YOUR DRIVEWAY**

**RESIDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEARING SNOW FROM IN FRONT OF THEIR MAILBOXES
NOT THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT, WASHOE COUNTY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE
TO MAILBOXES DURING SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS**

**ALTHOUGH OUR DRIVERS TRY TO KEEP SNOW BERMS IN DRIVEWAYS TO MINIMUM IF
IF THIS HAPPENS AND THEY ARE EXTREMELY LARGE (ICE CHUNKS, LARGE BALLS OF SNOW)
PLEASE CALL US AND WE WILL TRY TO REMOVE THEM A.S.A.P.**

**ON GARBAGE DAY PLEASE LEAVE YOUR TRASH CANS IN YOUR DRIVEWAY NOT IN THE STREET
SO THAT THE PLOWS DO NOT ACCIDENTLY KNOCK THEM OVER AND SCATTER THE TRASH**

**PLEASE REMOVE VECHICLES, TRAILERS AND RV'S FROM THE STREET SO THAT THE PLOWS
CAN CLEAR THE SNOW AND ICE**
